Costs are based on previous research trips as well as online searches. Airfare is from San Francisco International Airport to Pensacola International Airport, Florida. Typical per diem for meals in Pensacola is \$45 based on a reduced estimate from <a href="https://www.gsa.gov/perdiem">https://www.gsa.gov/perdiem</a>. I will need to rent a car for transportation to and from the University of West Florida and off-site locations where the collections, documents, and reports are held. During my stay in Pensacola, I will collect samples of glass beads from the five sites mentioned above, and I will ship them in the most secure and expedient way possible back to the University of California, Santa Cruz for analysis with LA-ICP-MS. Shipping costs vary depending on size and weight of package.
